



SURF TO SCHOOL DAY

Letter to Kids

You are reading this letter because you have put up your hand to host a SURF TO SCHOOL day at your school! AWESOME!! It's pretty simple really – a **'surf' themed mufti day** (think boardies, sundresses, Hawaiian shirts, zinc, sunnies, palm trees...) with a "pocket money/spare change" donation from everyone involved.

Your school will have a great day showing how easy it is for Kids to Make a Difference – and how to **have fun and help along the way.**

Here's how it works:

1. **Get your parents/guardians OK** (sign the agreement note with them)
2. **Get your school Principal's OK** for this fundraiser (we have written a letter for you to take to them)*see tips below
3. **Promote the day** by putting posters around school and at your school gates so it is a huge success (we have the cool poster – all you need to do is print copies out in A4 or A3) – there is a blank box for you to add in your school & date)
4. **Tell people about SURF TO SCHOOL** through conversations, social media (parent operated) and sharing the project page

5. **Speak at a school assembly (if you can or want)** about W4W and SURF TO SCHOOL - that would be awesome – get someone to film it & send it to us
6. **Take photos** of the day and write a short paragraph about the event – we will post it on the fundraiser page with the amount your school raised
7. **Get your school to put the money through the fundraiser page**
8. **Pass it on to a friend at another school.**

** Here are some tips for getting approval at school – print out the letter to the principal and a SURF TO SCHOOL poster to give them. Prepare a short speech that tells them why it is such a good cause (we have provided you with some information you can use). Present it with energy, conviction, a plan and a smile. They won't be able to say no.*

Some facts for you to know –

- One in 5 kids under 5 in Indonesia die from diseases caused by drinking dirty water
- One in 2 people in Indonesia don't have access to clean water
- Waves for Water aims to provide clean water to those who need it all around the world. You can learn more about Waves for Water at www.wavesforwater.org
- One Water filter costs \$50 and can provide clean water for up to 100 people for up to 5-10 years.
